

# Set up instructions Orlando Plus Base Unit

(set up with several people if possible)



1. Lay out poles and check that all the parts are present.
2. Lay out the roof panels with the centre's together and lace together. Start at the top and lace downwards in both directions – Tie off where the roof joins the side and lace the side separately .
3. Layout the groundsheet (if present) in the location chosen for the tent.
4. Lay out canvas (on top of the ground sheet if present) and peg down the corners using the larger pegs.  
**NB:** Make sure the tent is squared off.
5. Insert the 20 side poles and tension the guy ropes so the poles stay upright
6. From inside the tent with the entrances closed:  
Construct and lay out the telescopic ridge pole and the centre poles.  
Insert the centre pole top spikes into the ridge pole end eyelets.  
Place the top spikes through the roof eyelets and partially raise the roof.  
Adjust the telescopic ridge pole to the correct length, tighten and tie to the roof using the roof straps.  
Raise the roof into position – slacken guy ropes if required.  
**NB:** You MUST do both centre poles simultaneously.
7. With entrances closed: Re-tension the guy ropes to secure the tent.  
The guy ropes should be in line with the roof seams – reposition pegs if required.
8. Peg down the outside of the tent and ensure the mud flap is tucked in to the tent.

Please always ensure that your tent is safely pegged to the ground

Guy ropes and pegs should be marked/tagged to avoid tripping over in the dark

## Contents:

1 x tent canvas – shipped as 2 halves

2 x steel centre poles, 320 cm long, 4-piece,  $\varnothing$  32 x 1,5 mm

20 x set up poles, 160 cm long, 2-piece,  $\varnothing$  22 x 1 mm

1 x ridge pole, 2-piece telescopic, 120 - 155 cm long,  $\varnothing$  28/25 x 1 mm

guy ropes, pegs

(rolled into the tent canvas)
